



## Transmission Services

### PTSA Reform Initiative: Final Summary of Proposals (revised Feb. 24, 2012)

BPA has completed its initial review of all PTSA reform proposals that were received by January 20, 2012 and were not rejected by February 20, 2012. BPA found that there is sufficient reason to move forward with further discussions for each of the proposals received.

The following high-level summary provides an overview of the proposals submitted to BPA Transmission Services for the termination or modification of transmission service through the Precedent Transmission Service Agreement Reform initiative for the 2008, 2009 or 2010 Network Open Season processes. MW amounts are approximate.

*Note: BPA notes that this summary includes one additional proposal seeking termination of up to 400 MW, as well as one additional proposal for modification of 200 MW, which were not accounted for in the previous February 6 summary but were submitted within the deadlines.*
