# FERC NOPR

- March 20, 2014 – FERC issued a NOPR to alter the gas scheduling process
  - Move start of gas day from 9:00 am Central to 4:00 am Central
  - Adjust deadlines for submitting nominations
  - Modify intraday nomination timeline and introduce additional intraday nomination cycles.
  - Introduce multi-party transportation contracts
  - Clarification regarding no bump rule....

# Industry Feedback Highlights

- Various industry led efforts provided feedback and comments to FERC
- Thirteen proposals were narrowed to four
- PG&E led an effort that stressed the 2:00 am Pacific gas day start would pose challenges for worker safety and pipeline reliability.

# Industry Feedback Highlights (cont.)

- Consensus could not be reached on a complete alternative proposal however,
- Broad support for uniform changes to **intra-day and day-ahead scheduling/nomination cycles**

# New NAESB Gas Nomination Schedule to be Proposed

- NAESB Proposed Timely and Evening nomination cycles are the same as those in FERC's NOPR: **1:00 pm, 6:00 pm**
- The timelines for intraday cycles vary from the proposed NOPR. NAESB Proposes the following: **10:00 am, 2:30 pm, 7:00 pm**
- NAESB standards will not include an intraday 4 cycle and will not change the gas day start time
