Matching

6. Should a defender's feasibility to match look at all possibilities? In other words, it may be feasible for a defender to match if you change his start and/or stop time where it would not be possible if you changed just one. Should this be left to the TP, to pick either extending the stop time, start time, or both? Related to Motion 28.
7. What validation is required against a manual or adjusted system generated matching request? Can the defender make multiple attempts to get a valid matching request validated as long as it is within his allotted time to match?
8. Is a defender's matching request safe from being preempted as an A-List defender? Before he has a chance to submit it? After he submits it but before the TP has evaluated it?

Determining Defenders

9. What is the difference between skipping a defender due to not being on a commercially similar path, not having enough time to compete, or not having the ability to extend?
10. If it is not feasible for a defender to match, go ahead and compete him, but only require him to match for what is available. This will allow continuing down the queue looking for more defenders. Would rescind motion 28.
